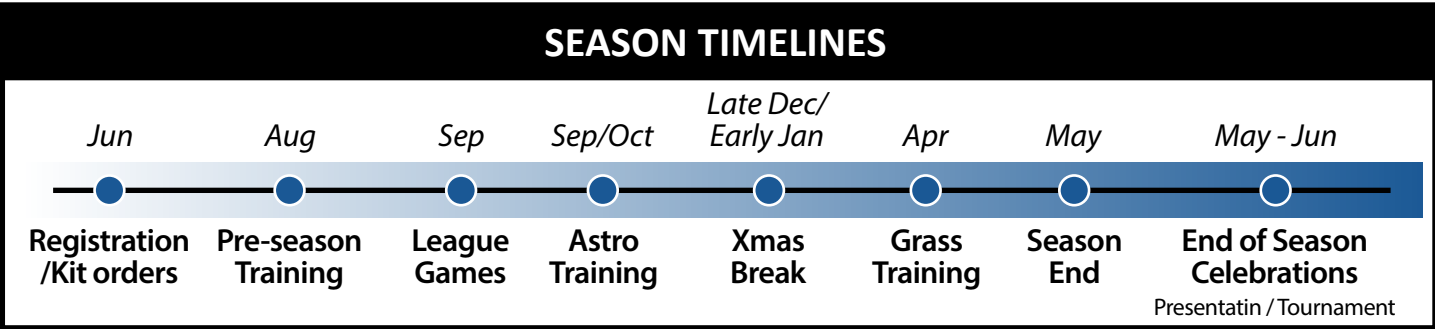
Firstly, a very warm welcome to your new club Buckingham Football Club Youth. We've put this summary together to help you get to know us
