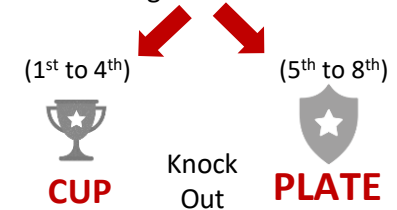
MATCH RULES
